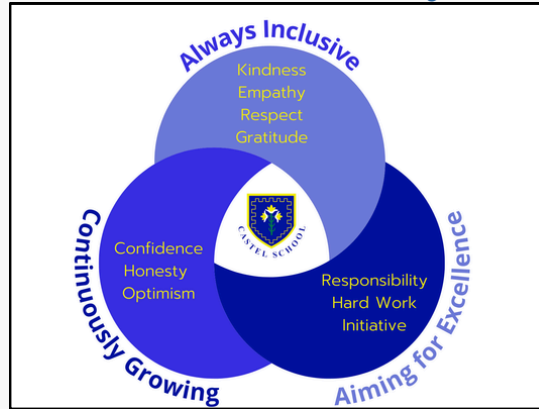

If your child is attending a residential trip in the summer term, please do keep an eye out for information letters coming home.

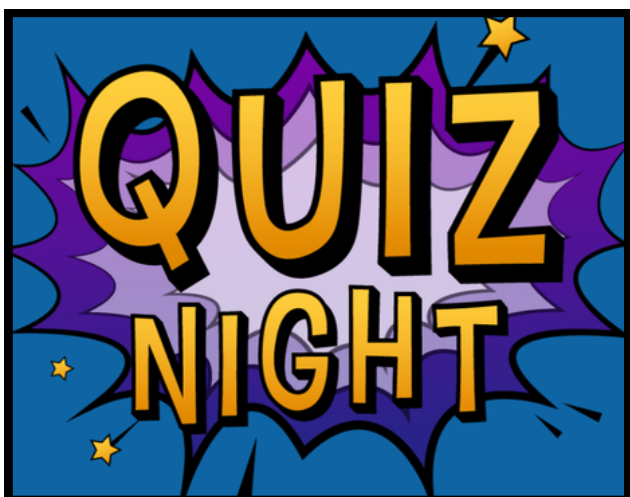
